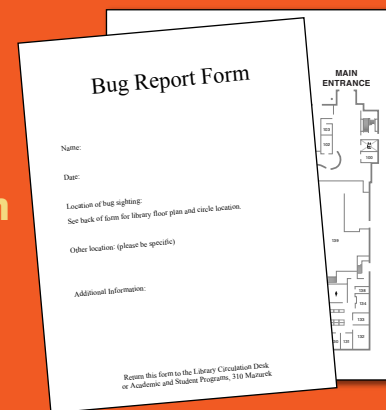


Bedbugs are a worldwide problem.

(1mm long)

If you think you have bed bugs at home, don't ignore the problem, seek a professional exterminator.

Adult
(5.5mm long)
Takes repeated blood meals over several weeks. Females lay up to 5 eggs per day, continuously.

Fifth Stage Nymphs
(4.5mm long)
Takes a blood meal and then moults.

Fourth Stage Nymphs
(3mm long)
Takes a blood meal and then moults.

Life Cycle of the Bed Bug

First Stage Nymphs
(1.5mm long)
Takes a blood meal and then moults.

Second Stage Nymphs
(2mm long)
Takes a blood meal and then moults.

Third Stage Nymphs
(2.5mm long)
Takes a blood meal and then moults.
